Class 1 – Open Hunter Shoeing

Time Allowed: 60 Minutes

Entry Fee £25

Open to all registered Farriers.

Competitors will be required to make 2 shoes:

One to be applied to a horse's foot provided made from fullered Concave steel bar.

One to be made to the judge's specification from fullered concave. Specimen provided.

*Specimens will **NOT** be tooled and fullered.*

Class 2 – 1st & 2nd Year Apprentice Shoemaking

Time Allowed: 45 Minutes

Entry Fee £15

*Safety Glasses **MUST** be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**.*

Open to 1st & 2nd Year Apprentice Farriers.

Competitors will be required to make 2 shoes to the Judge's specification.

Prizes: 1st £65 2nd £50 3rd £30 4th £20

Thursday 22nd June 2017

Class 3 – 3rd & 4th Year Apprentice Shoemaking

Time Allowed: 45 Minutes

Entry Fee £15

*Safety Glasses **MUST** be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**.*

Open to 3rd & 4th Year Apprentice Farriers.

Competitors will be required to make 2 shoes to the Judge's specification.

Prizes: 1st £65 2nd £50 3rd £30 4th £20

Thursday 22nd June 2017

Class 4 – Two Person Sports Horse Shoeing

Time Allowed: 65 Minutes

Entry Fee £50 per pair

Open to all registered Farriers.

Each team will be required to make 3 shoes:

Teams will shoe one side of a horse (front and hind) from Fullered Concave steel bar.

Shoes for the feet must possess two stud holes in each shoe, punched and tapped by the competitors.

Width and length to be determined by the horse's conformation and in accordance with the judge.

A specimen shoe will also be required to the judge's specification from either flat or concave steel.

Prizes: 1st = £150 2nd = £100 3rd = £60 4th = £40

Class 5 – Open Shoemaking

Time Allowed: 45 Minutes

This class will be run as two separate classes - one on Wednesday and one on Thursday. The specimen shoes will be different for each day. Competitors may only enter on **one day only**.

Entry Fee £25

Open to All Registered Farriers & Apprentice Farriers.

Competitors will be required to make 2 shoes to the Judges specification.

*Specimens will **NOT** be Tooled and Fullered.*

Prizes: 1st £45 2nd £35 3rd £25 4th £15

RULES AND CONDITIONS

Safety Glasses:

*Safety Glasses **MUST** be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**.* Open competitors are strongly advised to wear all appropriate protective equipment. Any injury resulting from not wearing protective equipment is not the responsibility of the competition or showground.

Timekeeping:

Rounds will start and finish on the bell. Anyone still working after the bell will not score on that section i.e. Nail and finish or Specimen. Timings will be called out to all competitors at regular intervals during each round.

Steel:

Steel to be cut outside the forge building in the area provided.

All materials provided and work completed remains the property of the Lincolnshire Agricultural Society.

Strikers may be used in all classes.

The Judge's decision is final.

Entries will be taken on a strictly **first come first served** basis (inclusive of payment), please make cheques payable to **Lincolnshire Agricultural Society**.
