

#### Class 2: ROADSTER PAIRS SHOEING – Saturday

Make and fit one front and hind ¾ Fullered Shoe and make one specimen plain stamp Caulk and Wedge.

Time: 75 Minutes.

#### Class 3: 1st and 2nd YEAR APPRENTICE SHOE MAKING – Saturday & Sunday

Make one pair of Concave hind shoes 1/4 Clips. Made from 7/8 x 3/8. x 13 inches

Time: 45 Minutes

#### Class 4: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> YEAR APPRENTICE SHOE MAKING – Saturday & Sunday

- 5. The committee reserves the absolute right to refuse any entry.
- 6. Medals will not be awarded for less than 6 competitors in a class.
- 7. Prize money will no longer be sent in the mail, any unclaimed prizes will be returned to Branch funds.
- 8. Judges decision is Final.
- Entries close Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
- 10. Competitors compete at their own risk.
- 11. Shoes will be kept by the competition.
