Class 1

1hr rounds for each pair with a 10 minute change over time between each pair.

1x Master and 1x Apprentice to each make a specimen shoe

Fire:	coke fire
Time allowed:	60 minutes
Results after total time:	4x master specimen shoes and 4x apprentice shoes per team

Class 2

1hr rounds for each pair with a 10 minute change over between each pair

Each pair:

- Apprentice dresses the allocated foot.
- Master makes and fits a plain stamped massalotte clipped beveled front or a plain stamped caulk and wedge hind to the dressed foot.
- Apprentice makes a specimen diagonal from shoeing the foot ie: **shoeing the left fore make a right hind specimen**
- Master to nail the shoe on
- Apprentice to clench up and finish off the foot

Apprentice specimen shoe to be handed in as they leave the anvil.

Fire:	coke fire
Time allowed:	60 minutes per pair
Results after total time:	shod horse by the master and 4x apprentice specimen shoes.

Class 3

3hr rolling clock, No change over times.

1x Master and 1x Apprentice to each make a specimen shoe

Fire:	coke fire
Time allowed:	180 minutes
Results after total time:	4x Master specimen shoes and 4x Apprentice shoes per team

Class 4

3hr rolling clock, No change over times.

Each pair:

- Apprentice dresses the allocated foot.
- Master makes and fits a 3/4 fullered massalotte clipped front/hind to the allocated foot.
- Apprentice makes a specimen diagonal from shoeing the foot ie: **shoeing the left fore make a right hind specimen**
- Master to nail the shoe on
- Apprentice to clench up and finish off the foot

Only one master and one apprentice to be working on the anvil at one time. Shoes can be removed prior to class starting and rough cutting will be allowed at the judge's approval. Apprentice specimen shoe to be handed in as they leave the anvil and the next apprentice starts. He/she **will not** be given their shoe back if there is any time left over at the end.

Fire:	coke fire
Time allowed:	180 minutes per team
Results after total time:	shod horse by the Master and 4x Apprentice specimen shoes.

Class 5

1hr rounds for each pair

Each pair:

- Apprentice dresses the allocated foot.
 - Master makes and fits a plain stamped massalotte clipped front or hind to the dressed foot.
 - Apprentice makes a specimen from one of the shoeing classes
 - Master to nail the shoe on
 - Apprentice to clench up and finish off the foot
- Apprentice specimen shoe to be handed in once the class has finished.

Fire:

coke fire

Time allowed:

60 minutes per pair

Results after total time:

shod foot by the Master and 1x Apprentice specimen

Class 6

45 mins per pair.

1x Master and 1x Apprentice to each make a specimen shoe.

Specimen shoes are to be handed in at the end of each round.

Master and Apprentice shoes are to be selected from the shoemaking classes.

Fire:

coke fire

Time allowed:

45 minutes per pair

Results after total time:

1x Master and 1x apprentice shoe per team
