



RULES FOR THE BFBA NATIONAL APPRENTICE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. The 'class' to be named the 'BFBA National Apprentice Championship'.
2. The 'class' to be open to those competitors who are officially recorded as 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th year apprentices with the Farriers Registration Council.
3. Judge to be chosen from the WCF List of Approved Judges.
4. The BFBA Chief Steward to be in attendance in order to ensure that the class is run in accordance with the rules. Expenses (travel/accommodation if required) to be paid by host Society/Organisation.
5. The host Society/Organisation to provide a minimum of £100 prize vouchers to the Champion, £50.00 to the Reserve Champion and prize cards to the top eight.

WCF Bronze Medal to Champion

BFBA (NAFBAE) Bronze Medal to Reserve Champion

6. The **J & A Ferrie WCF Shield** to be awarded to the Champion,
THE TROPHY TO REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE BFBA.
7. Entry fee £35.00 per competitor, entry fees to be kept by the host Society/Organisation.
8. The class follows the set format which is:

Each competitor to make:

Front Straight Bar Shoe from 7/8" x 3/8" concave section, to be 5 1/2" wide by 5 3/4" long.

and

Front Deep Seated Open Shoe from 1" x 1/2" flat section to be 5 1/2" wide by 5 3/4" long.

Time limit 50 minutes

Apprentice Striker allowed
