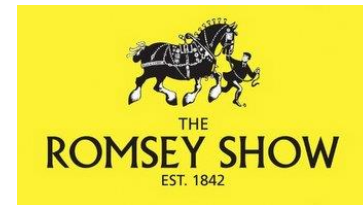

## CONDITIONS

Each competitor may have more than one striker to run the fire.  
(Advised)

It is the competitors' responsibility to look after the fire from the previous round.
