

Rules

Class 1 N Brown front feet, D Smith Hind feet

- You must provide a horse holder and the team is responsible for the horse from the minute the horse comes into the forge until it leaves.
- Near side will be shod first
- 1 Anvil with only one person working on it at once
- 1 free standing vice
- No marking of any steel until the class starts
- you must produce a full set (i.e. 1 Nf, 1 Of, 1 NH & 1 OH) of tool and fullers by the end of the 2 rounds, it doesn't matter who makes what as long as it is one shoe each

Class 2 D Smith front feet, N Brown Hind feet

- the horse must be held at all times whilst in the forge by a team member
- 1 Anvil with only one person working on it at once
- 1 free standing vice
- No marking of any steel until the class starts
- Only 1 foot to be off the ground at once

Class 3

- 1 Anvil with only one person working on it at once
- 2 free standing vices
- No marking of any steel until the class starts
- All steel and ally is pre cut but feel free to bring your own spare Ali as I will only have one bit per competitor.
- Hammer Finish means no rasping, no set hammers of any kind and no flatters.

All scores will be out of 10 points. Nails supplied and sponsored by Mustad

All work must stop at the end of each round and shoes not to be touched again until instructed by a steward,

Instant disqualification if any of these rules are not adhered to. (PPE is advised)

Apprentice & Individual Rules

Classes 4, 5 & 6

- 1 Anvil with only one person working on it at once
- 1 free standing vice
- No marking of any steel until the class starts
- Hammer Finish means no rasping, no set hammers of any kind and no flatters.
- All scores out of 10 points.
- All nails supplied and sponsored by Mustad
- PPE must be worn at all times** whilst competing and provided by yourself

All work must stop at the end of each round and shoes not to be touched again until instructed by a steward,

Instant disqualification if any of these rules are not adhered to.
