All shoemaking classes will be done out of the back of your own van. You will need to provide your own forge and anvil as well as relevant PPE, including safety glasses.

Class 1 First and Second Year Shoemaking

Apprentices will be required to make two concave shoes to the judge's specification, time allowed 45 minutes.

Prizes £25, £15, £10.

Entry fee £10

Class 2 Third and Fourth Year Shoemaking

Apprentices will be required to make 1 concave shoe and one shoe from flat steel to the judges specification's, time allowed 50 minutes.

Prizes £25, £15, £10.

Entry fee £10

Class 3 Open Shoemaking (qualified farriers only)

You will be required to make 2 shoes to the judge's specifications, time allowed 50 minutes.

Prizes £35, £25, £15.

Entry fee £15

Class 4 First and Second Year Speed Class

Apprentices will be required to make a pair of fronts and a pair of hinds out of concave section unclipped, time allowed 30 minutes.

Prizes £25, £15, £10.

Entry fee £10

Class 5 third and fourth year speed class

Apprentices will be required to make a pair of front shoes and a pair of hind shoes out of concave section front shoes to be clipped, time allowed 30 minutes.

Prizes £25, £15, £10.

Entry fee £10

Class 6 Open speed shoemaking (qualified farriers only)

You will be required to make a pair of fronts and a pair of hinds out of concave section, front and hinds both to be clipped, time allowed 30 minutes.

Prizes £35, £25, £15.

Entry fee £15

Class 7 Eagle eye

To make a single shoe to fit a dead foot on the day unclipped, time allowed 15 minutes. Half of the proceeds will go to the winner and the other half will go to the Farriers Foundation.
