### **Class 1: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year apprentice**

*Safety Glasses MUST be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in DISQUALIFICATION.*

A pair of concave fronts.

Time allowed 40 minutes

Entry Fee: £10

Rosettes up to 5<sup>th</sup> place and Prize money up to 3<sup>rd</sup> place

### **Class 2: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year apprentice**

*Safety Glasses MUST be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in DISQUALIFICATION.*

A pair of  $\frac{3}{4}$  fullered hinds.

Time allowed 45 minutes

Entry Fee: £10

Rosettes up to 5<sup>th</sup> place and Prize money up to 3<sup>rd</sup> place

### Class 3: Open Shoe Making

Two shoes to judges requirements.

Time allowed 45 minutes

Entry Fee: £10

Rosettes up to 5<sup>th</sup> place and Prize money up to 3<sup>rd</sup>

### Class 4: Fun class

Bring a shoe to be judged on the day, any size or type. **Shoe must be made by the competitor.**

Free Entry

Rosettes and prize money for 1<sup>st</sup> in Open and Apprentice

## RULES

- **VEHICLES MUST BE ON THE SHOW GROUND BY 10.30 AM**
- Vehicles must carry a fire extinguisher
- Rasping and Pre-heats allowed in all classes
- Safety Glasses: *Safety Glasses MUST be worn by all Apprentices whilst competing. Failure to do so will result in DISQUALIFICATION.*
- Timekeeping: Rounds will start and finish on the bell. Timings will be called out to all competitors at regular intervals during each round.
- All materials provided and work completed remains the property of the World Horse Welfare Show.
- Strikers may not be used in any classes.
- Judges decision is final.
- Entries will be taken on a first come first served basis.
