The Forge HCMR would like to invite you to take part in the Household Cavalry Mounted Regiment's annual farriery competition "Cavalry Black Pairs". This year will be the 21st anniversary of the competition and gives qualified and apprentice farriers from around the world the opportunity to compete alongside the British Army.

Please find below the competition schedule with the entry forms; please ensure that you write both your name and your intended partner's name, along with the vehicle details and return to address stated as soon as possible, if you wish to attend. This competition attracts a large amount of interest and will be run on a first come, first served, basis. If you would like to request a time for your round, please indicate this on the entry form and we will try to honour these requests' wherever possible.

THE COMPETITION

JUDGES: Mr Jim and Allan Ferrie FWCF

Each pair must consist of two registered farriers.

Each pair will shoe either the left or right side of a Cavalry Black, with a plain stamped front and a plain stamped caulkin and wedge hind. The shoes are to be made to the judge's specification and both shoes are to be toe clipped. The sections of metal available are 1 x $\frac{1}{4}$ and 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ x $\frac{1}{2}$.

Time allowed: 1 Hour

Entry fee: £70.00 per pair. £25 per apprentice.

NCO's Mess

As we did last year, we will be hosting all competitors in our Mess, it is a bar with a lot of historical importance to our regiment. The mess will be open from 1600 hrs till 2200hrs. Please be aware your vehicles can not be left over night in camp so please be aware of the amount of alcohol you intend to consume.

The minimum order of dress that is permitted in our NCO's mess:

- Collared shirt or polo shirt
- Jeans or chinos
- Clean shoes NO trainers

If you don't meet this dress code, you will be asked to leave the Mess as this has been directed down by our Regimental Corporal Major as the minimum requirement of dress.





TROPHIES AND PRIZES

The prize giving will take place in the NCO's Mess at 17:30hrs.

- A prize for the Best individual.
- A prize for the Best Military pair.
- · Best apprentice.
- · Best military apprentice.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Each competitor must comply with the Health and Safety Regulations as laid down in Regimental Standing Orders (Safety equipment **MUST** be worn at all times).
- 2. No two farriers working on the same anvil at the same time, only one anvil is to be used per pair.
- 3. Each competitor is to trim their own allocated foot.
- 4. Start and finish on the bell. Rough cutting will be the judge's decision.
- 5. All competitors must bring their own tools.
- 6. The Household Cavalry Mounted Regiment will provide the horses, metal and nails.
- 7. The judge's decision is final, and he will be prepared to deal with any questions after the results have been declared.
- 8. All overseas competitors must apply to the Farriers Registration Council for an application to complete and proof of this must be shown prior to competing

APPRENTICE ROUNDS

These rounds will be from gas fires and will be roadster shoes.

1ST and 2nd year apprentice

3rd and 4th year apprentice

SHOES-TBC TIME- 1hr

SECURITY AND CONDITIONS

- . Please return entries ASAP for security measures.
- . Please state on the entry form both farriers' names in the pair.
- . As parking is limited, we ask that pairs arrive in one vehicle.
- . On arrival all competitors must book in.
- . Passes will be issued for the vehicles and must be displayed at all times; these passes must be returned at the end of the competition.
