Master to make, fit, nail and finish one FULLY fullered front shoe, toe clipped, appropriate to riding style. Apprentice to make, fit, nail and finish one concave hind shoe quarter clipped to a riding style.

COMPETITION RULES

- Competitors in Class 1 must be registered farriers.3rd/4th year apprentices in Class 1 and 2 must have his/her ATF present during the class, or a pre-arranged cosupervising qualified farrier.
- 2. Apprentices must be under an approved apprenticeship scheme.
- Safety glasses, protective footwear i.e. steel toe caps and aprons or chaps must be worn by <u>ALL</u> competitors, all competitors should maintain safe working practice at all times.
- 4. The judge will provide details of specimen shoes required.
- 5. Apprentices in Class 1 and 2 must have a qualified farrier supervising. Direct intervention may affect marks.
- 6. Competitors must provide their own tools and safety equipment.
- 7. The Ice Man Pairs Championship will be decided over the classes 1,2,3 on total individual points.
- 8. The judges decision will be final.
- 9. Competitors will use gas forges for all classes.
- 10. Strikers/fireman will be allowed as necessary in class 1,2 and 3 only
- 11. Pictures of specimens for selected classes will be released prior to the competition and posted online
- 12. Only competitors and officials are allowed in the shoeing area.
- 13. Prize giving for all classes will take place on Thursday.
- 14. Prizes may not be awarded to those not attending prize giving.
- 15. Foot preparation with nippers only will be allowed prior to the start of classes 1 and 2
- 16. Professional behaviour should be maintained at all times by all farriers and apprentices in and around the competition area. Please remember this is a public demonstration. Improper or unprofessional conduct will result in immediate disgualification.

Camping and caravans are allowed nearby on the show ground with advance booking.
