Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 1<sup>st</sup> prize £80 a pair 2<sup>nd</sup> £70 a pair, 3<sup>rd</sup> £50 a pair, 4th, 5th Best Prepared foot £10 Best Individual - WCF Silver Medal

## 2. Open Roadster Horse Shoeing

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July 1<sup>st</sup> prize £80 a pair 2<sup>nd</sup> £70 a pair, 3<sup>rd</sup> £50 a pair, 4th, 5th Best Prepared foot £10 Best Individual - BFBA Silver Medal

## 3. Open Shoemaking Pairs

For registered farriers & apprentices Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £80 a pair 2<sup>nd</sup> £70 a pair, 3<sup>rd</sup> £50 a pair, 4th, 5th Best Individual - WCF Bronze Medal

## 4. Open Heavy Horse Shoemaking Pairs

To be held over the three days, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £80 a pair 2<sup>nd</sup> £70 a pair, 3<sup>rd</sup> £50 a pair, 4th, 5th

#### 5. Apprentice

To be held over the three days, **1**<sup>st</sup> & **2**<sup>nd</sup> **year**, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £30 and a BFBA Bronze Medal 2<sup>nd</sup> £25, 3<sup>rd</sup> £20, 4th, 5th **3**<sup>rd</sup> & **4**<sup>th</sup> **year**, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £30 and a BFBA Bronze Medal 2<sup>nd</sup> £25, 3<sup>rd</sup> £20, 4th, 5th

## 6. Farriers Forge & Bring

For registered farriers & apprentices 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £25, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize £20, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize £15, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>.

## CONDITIONS

## Classes 1-4 Competitors to share 1 fire, 1 anvil, 1 vice. One competitor on the anvil at one time. All points from classes 1 to 4 are counted towards the championship.

Class 1 - 55 mins Each team of competitors to shoe one side of the horse with fullered concave in the time required. Each competitor is responsible for one foot only.

Class 2 - 60 mins Each team of competitors to shoe one side of the horse with a fullered shoe from flat stock in the time required. Each competitor is responsible for one foot only.

Class 3 - 55 mins Each team of competitors will be required to make a one tool and fullered preventer front shoe from 5/8 square and one plain stamp calk and wedge roadster made from 14 1/2' 1 1/4' x 1/2".

Class 4 - 55 mins Each team of competitors will be required to make a pair of heavy horse shoes to match the judges specimen shoe as follows:

1 x Front bevel 18" 1 1/2" x 1/2".

1 x Hind bevel 17" 1 1/2" x 1/2"

#### Class 5 - 50 mins

 $1^{st}$  &  $2^{nd}$  year – One plain stamp front with reverse heal check on lateral branch unclipped from 1" x 3/8 and one hunter hind clipped from 7/8 x 7/16

 $3^{rd}$  &  $4^{th}$  year – One 3/4 fullered front clipped from 1" x 3/8 and one plain stamped hind with massolette toe clip from 1" x 3/8.

Class 6 All entries for Farriers Forge & Bring to be at show stand by 9am on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July. Designed for farriers who may not wish to compete under competition conditions. Competitors own interpretation of a Straight Bar shoe measuring 5 1/2 inches wide.

All work must be completed within the time specified.

Competitors must accept the foot allocated to them. Foot to be marked before hot fitting.

Each Apprentice competitor must make their own arrangements for a striker. The strikers name must be shown on the entry form.

Competitors are required to be present 30 mins prior to start of class, failure to comply will disqualify.

The right to limit the number of entries is reserved.

All decisions of the Judge on all entries are final.

Safety equipment (aprons, boots and glasses) must be worn.

Competitors compete at their own risk.
