CLASS 1 – OPEN AND INTERMEDIATE MNC RIDING HORSE SHOEING – STAFFORDSHIRE TROPHY

Wednesday 28TH May

OPEN to make, fit, nail and finish one FULLY fullered front shoe, toe clipped, appropriate to riding style. INTERMEDIATE/ 3RD AND 4TH YEAR APPRENTICES to make, fit, nail and finish one CONCAVE hind shoe quarter clipped to a riding style. Plus, one specimen shoe to judges specification. Made between the 2 competitors.

OPEN to make, fit, nail and finish one 3/4 fullered hind shoe toe clipped on the foot. INTERMEDIATE3RD AND 4TH YEAR APPRENTICES to make, fit, nail and finish one 3/4 fullered front shoe toe clipped on the foot. Appropriate to driving style. Plus, two specimen shoes to the judge's specification. ONE MADE BY EACH COMPETITOR

CLASS 3 - OPEN AND INTERMEDIATE NWT HORSESHOES SHOEMAKING CLASS - EJA FROST MEMORIAL TROPHY

Two shoes made to judges' specification. Pictures of specimens for this class will be posted online. ONE SHOE TO BE MADE BY THE INTERMEDIATE/ 3RD AND 4TH APPRENTICE AND THE OTHER TO BE MADE BY THE OPEN COMPETITOR.

COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Intermediate competitors are not to have been placed in a shoemaking or shoeing class or under an approved apprenticeship scheme.
- 2. Competitors in Class 1 must be registered farriers. <u>3rd/4th year apprentices in</u> <u>Class 1 and 2 must have his/her ATF present during the class, or a pre-</u> <u>arranged co-supervising qualified farrier.</u>
- 3. Apprentices must be under an approved apprenticeship scheme.
- 4. Safety glasses, protective footwear i.e. steel toe caps and aprons or chaps must be worn by ALL competitors, all competitors should always maintain safe working practice.
- 5. The judge will provide details of specimen shoes required.
- 6. Apprentices in Class 1 and 2 must have a qualified farrier supervising. Direct intervention may affect marks.
- 7. Competitors must provide their own tools and safety equipment.
- 8. The Ice Man Pairs Championship will be decided over classes 1,2 & 3 on total individual points.
- 9. The judge's decision will be final.
- 10. Competitors will use gas forges for all classes.
- 11. Strikers/fireman will be allowed as necessary in class 1, 2 and 3
- 12. Pictures of specimens for selected classes will be released prior to the competition and posted online
- 13. Only competitors and officials are allowed in the shoeing area.
- 14. Prize giving for all classes will take place on Thursday.
- 15. Prizes may not be awarded to those not attending prize giving.
- 16. Foot preparation with nippers only will be allowed prior to the start of classes 1 and 2
- 17. Professional behaviour should be maintained at all times by all farriers and apprentices in and around the competition area. Please remember this is a public demonstration. Improper or unprofessional conduct will result in immediate disqualification.

Camping and caravans are allowed nearby on the show ground with advance booking.
