1. Open Hunter Pairs Shoeing

Friday 4th July 1st prize £100 a pair 2nd £80 a pair, 3rd £60 a pair Best Prepared foot £10 Best Individual

2. Open Roadster Horse Shoeing

Saturday 5th July 1st prize £100 a pair 2nd £80 a pair, 3rd £60 a pair Best Prepared foot £10 Best Individual

3. Open Shoemaking Pairs

For registered farriers & apprentices Sunday 6th July 1st Prize £100 a pair 2nd £80 a pair, 3rd £60 a pair Best Individual

4. Open Heavy Horse Shoemaking Pairs

To be held over the three days, 1st prize £100 a pair 2nd £80 a pair, 3rd £60 a pair Best Individual

5. Speed Shoemaking pairs (NEW for 2025)

For registered farriers & apprentices To be held over the three days, 1st prize £80.00 a pair 2nd £60 a pair, 3rd £40 a pair Best Individual

6. Apprentice

To be held over the three days,

1st & 2nd year,

1st prize £30 and a BFBA Bronze Medal

2nd £25, 3rd £20, 4th, 5th

3rd & 4th year,

1st prize £30 and a BFBA Bronze Medal

2nd £25, 3rd £20, 4th, 5th

CONDITIONS

Classes 1-5 Competitors to share 1 fire, 1 anvil, 1 vice. One competitor on the anvil at one time. All points from classes 1 to 5 are counted towards the championship.

Class 1 - 75 mins Each team of competitors to shoe one side of the horse with fullered concave in the time required and make a tool and fullered straight bar shoe from 5/8 square. Each competitor is responsible for one foot only.

Class 2 - 75 mins Each team of competitors to shoe one side of the horse with a fullered shoe from flat stock in the time required and make a plain stamped Roaster made from 14" of 1 1/4" x 1/2". Each competitor is responsible for one foot only.

Class 3 - 60 mins Each team of competitors will be required to make one deep seated fully fullered bar shoe from 17" of 1" x 1/2" and a diamond toe hind with a trailer and a massalote toe clip reverse graduated made from 11" of 5/8 square.

Class 4 - 60 mins Each team of competitors will be required to make one front and one hind shoe to the judges specimen as follows:

- 1 x Hammer finish front bevel with massalote toe clip 17 1/2" of 1 1/4" x 1/2".
- 1 x Rasped finish double calk hind 17 1/2" of 1 1/4" x 1/2".

Class 5 - 30 mins Each team of competitors will be required to make a set of shoes (one front and one hind per competitor) to the judges specimen as follows:

Hunter fronts from 13 1/2" of 7/8 x 7/16

Riding style hinds from 13" of 7/8" x 3/8"

One anvil and one vice to be used.

Class 6 - 50 mins

 1^{st} & 2^{nd} year – One Hunter front 12 1/2" of 3/4" x 7/16" and a Plain stamped hind 12 1/2" of 3/4" x 3/8"

 3^{rd} & 4^{th} year – One Hunter Calk and wedge hind 13 1/2" of 3/4" x 7/16" and 3/4" fullered Front 13 1/2" of 1' x 3/8"

All work must be completed within the time specified.

Competitors must accept the foot allocated to them. Foot to be marked before hot fitting.

Each Apprentice competitor must make their own arrangements for a striker. The strikers name must be shown on the entry form.

Competitors are required to be present 30 mins prior to start of class, failure to comply will disqualify.

The right to limit the number of entries is reserved.

All decisions of the Judge on all entries are final.

Safety equipment (aprons, boots and glasses) must be worn.

Competitors compete at their own risk.
