Class 1: The Robert O'Hare MF Memorial Open Shoeing

Handmade shoe from concave steel on the horse's hoof and a concave caulking and wedge specimen. Fit to be confirmed.

Scores will go towards the overall show champion.

Class 2: The Irish Field Two Person Open Shoemaking

€80

per team

Contestants to make two shoes, one shoe each to the judge's description.

- Each contestant can only enter once
- · Competitors to make one shoe each
- Individual scores will go towards overall show champion
- Cash prize for first place €500, second place €200 and third place €100 – split between pairs.
- · Please include both your names with the entry fee

Coke fire | Striker allowed | one vice per pair | Time allowed: 50 min

Class 3: Bodner Tools Shoeing Class

€50

Handmade shoe from concave steel on the horse's hoof, and a national hunt racehorse hind shoe made from concave section as the specimen. Fit to be confirmed.

- This class will be open to intermediate competitors who have not placed 1st or 2nd in an open or intermediate shoeing class in the past two years.
- This class can be entered by 3rd/4th year apprentice once written approval is supplied from their master, along with their masters contact details.

Coke fire | Fireman allowed no striker | Time allowed: 50 min



Class 4: HRI Equuip 3rd/4th year Apprentice Shoemaking

€40

Competitors will be required to make two shoes to the judges' description.

Gas fire | Fireman allowed no striker | Time allowed: 50 min

Class 5: HRI Equuip 1st/2nd Apprentice Shoemaking

€40

Competitors will be required to make two shoes to the judges' description.

Gas fire | Fireman allowed no striker | Time allowed: 50 min

Class 6: Eagle Eye

€15

Competitor is allowed 10 seconds to look at foot, 10 minutes to forge a shoe to fit to the judge's description.

- · Class will be split into open and apprentices.
- Points awarded from this class will go towards overall show champion

Gas fire | No fireman allowed | Time allowed: 10 min

- Apprentice class entrants must also specify your year and master/fireman.
